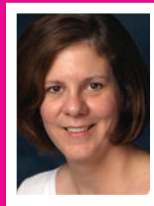

## WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF THE PARTNERSHIP?

Sherman is now home to five Children's Memorial Pediatric hospitalists. Available in the Pediatric Unit 24-hours a day, 365 days a year, the hospitalists can:

- Work with you and your pediatrician
- Offer assistance and expertise in emergencies, high-risk deliveries and other pediatric-related services
- Provide timely consults to the Emergency Department

## WHAT IS A HOSPITALIST?

A hospitalist is a medical specialist who provides quality medical treatment to individuals while they are in the hospital. Hospitalists do not maintain a private outside practice, so their time is devoted solely to caring for hospitalized patients. Hospitalists' responsibilities include:

- Specializing in all aspects of a patient's care—from admission until discharge.
- Working closely with the patient's primary care physician and/or specialists involved.

## CAN I MAKE AN APPOINTMENT WITH A CHILDREN'S MEMORIAL HOSPITALIST?

No, your pediatrician will decide if your child will see a Children's Memorial hospitalist. If your child does not have a pediatrician, a Children's Memorial hospitalist will be their primary physician during treatment at Sherman Hospital. After a Children's Memorial hospitalist cares for your child, you will follow up with your pediatrician or be referred to a pediatrician in your area.

## MY CHILD CURRENTLY RECEIVES TREATMENT AT CHILDREN'S MEMORIAL HOSPITAL; CAN WE COME TO SHERMAN FOR TREATMENT?

Contact your pediatrician and/or your Children's Memorial doctor to decide the best location for your child's specific needs.

## HOW WILL I BE BILLED?

The billing process is the same as if your child were to see any doctor at Sherman Hospital. You will receive a bill from Sherman Hospital for hospital fees and a separate bill from Children's Memorial Medical Group for the professional fee.
